Case Reviews and Care Providers: Hearing Your Voice



All 58 counties in California are beginning to conduct case reviews to take an in-depth look at how we are serving children and families. This means that we are carefully reviewing our files; as well as talking with clients, social workers, and care providers of our children in foster and relative care.

Hearing from relative and foster care providers is vital to collecting the stories behind the numbers, and helps the Department improve our system.

If a child who is currently in your care, or was in your care during the review period, is randomly selected for review, you will be contacted for an interview. These interviews are completely voluntary, and are also confidential, meaning it will not influence the case in any way and will not be shared with caseworker(s).

The interviews focus on:

- ✦ Kids needs
- ✦ Care provider needs
- ✦ Whether care providers were kept involved in service and case planning for the children in their care
- ✦ Department efforts to achieve permanency for youth
