PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CC3.0 TRAINERS (March 2018)**

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**WHAT ARE THE PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS FOR THOSE WHO WISH TO PROVIDE 'STAND & DELIVER' TRAININGS ON CC3.0 TOPICS?**

**I. REQUIRED before being allowed to train CC3.0:**

A. *Attend 1-day CC3.0 T4T:* Note: Trainers who attended the full day of the Sept 2016 BAA Trainer Summit met this initial requirement, as that Trainer Summit was designed to deliver CC3.0 T4T content.

B. *Review the 3 overarching thematic CC3.0 T4T webinars:* Cultural Humility; Trauma-Informed Practice; Assessment. (Note: There is a 4<sup>th</sup> overarching T4T webinar that is optional: Overview of CC3.0 and Core Practice Model.) BAA needs to track Trainer and Field Advisor completion of these T4T webinars.

C. *Observe the CC3.0 in-class day of a training you'd like to train (and this includes reviewing an e-module if there is a prerequisite e-module assigned to an in class day you want to train).*

D. *SDM and ICWA trainers:* Trainers on these topics will need to have attended an SDM 3.0 or ICWA-specific T4T, respectively, in order to train these topic areas.

**II. Recommended for Training CC3.0:**
