

CPM/CCR Implementation Support Activities

- The *Bay Area Managers Meeting (BAMM)* will be reconvening in August and will meet quarterly thereafter. The focus of this group will be on Core Practice Model implementation as well as Implementation Science to better support CCR implementation.
- We held a successful *Leadership Coaching Training* with our Bay Area Child Welfare Directors in June and will continue working with this group in the coming year. The training not only reinforced the Leadership Behaviors of the CPM but provided an overview of the Art of Coaching, so Directors are familiar with the language, skills and tools being used by managers and supervisors. The training was also intended to build skills that support the organizational change needed to implement CPM and CCR.
- At the urging of the Bay Area Regional Children's Committee (BARCC) BAA will begin development of a *Child Welfare Directors Training Program* intended to provide much needed support for new Child Welfare Directors. The program will include training modules and coaching to better orient them to the job and support their development as Directors. The program will incorporate CPM Leadership and Implementation Science. We anticipate the training modules will be completed by the Winter of 2019.
- In partnership with Casey Family Programs and Harder & Company we will hold a *Regional CCR Learning Collaborative* in the Fall and then reconvene a workgroup to further develop a proof of concept for a regional system of care that focuses on Mobile Response and Stabilization Services (MRSS).
- BAA will be providing training and TA on the *Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths Assessment (CANS)*. We will be reaching out to determine how much training and what is needed for Technical Assistance.
- The *Common Core Training* is under a review process that will result in revisions that will incorporate CPM, CANS, Child and Family Teaming (CFT) and Level of Care (LOC).
- *Supervisor Core* is in the midst of a revision and will incorporate CPM and coaching into the new version.
- We will be updating our materials on LOC and CFT trainings based on recent updates from the state and will be providing more training as requested by counties.
