



Bay Area Academy Regional Training Program

Fourth Quarter/ Year End Report
Fiscal Year 2009 – 2010

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INTRODUCTION and SUMMARY

This report represents the Fourth Quarter/Year-End Report for FY2009-10 and covers the April – June 2010 period and cumulative data from the past 12 months. The decline in child welfare staffing at the county level, with the corresponding reduction in need for core training, is reflected in the training statistics this past fiscal year. Overall, the total number of core trainings has declined (from 7 Core cycles in FY08-09 to 4 cycles in FY09-10), class sizes are generally smaller, and the demand for more supervisory, advanced and Best Practices trainings has increased. This past year, the BAA also provided many 1/2 day trainings which take as much prep and planning as a full day, yet are counted as a 1/2 day. These half day trainings were requested by the counties as a way to minimize staff absences from work and impact on client services.

A two-year comparison of FY08-09 and 09-10 statistics shows interesting trends. The number of trainees this past year increased from 4,124 to 4,785 over FY08-09, a 16% increase. The number of participant hours has declined 12.6% (from 25,810.5 to 22,566). There was almost a 50% drop in total Core training days from 130.5 in FY08-09 to 66 this past year—a decline due to counties needing fewer Core cycles. This statistic reflects how budget constraints have affected the ability of counties to hire or maintain child welfare staffing, and their corresponding need for Core training. However, the most significant trend is that counties asked for and received more training for supervisors, Best Practices in child welfare, and Advanced courses to meet individualized county needs. There was a 50% increase in Supervisory training days (from 12 to 18 days), a 109.5% increase in Best Practices training (from 10.5 to 22 days), and a 29.1% increase in Advanced days (from 58.49 to 75.5 days). Clearly counties are adapting to the changing landscape of funding, staffing and service demands by asking for greater customization in training.

The fourth quarter culminated in the completion of several cycles of Core training and Advanced or specialized topics. The BAA completed two Advanced days in the “Undoing Racism” continuum with Kenneth Hardy and Margaret Jackson each training a full day each.

Four (4) cycles of Core were completed with the 5th cycle in process and not completing until next fiscal year. This 5th cycle is for Santa Clara County. These four cycles were not the full 24 days since they were done for the larger Bay Area counties that train some of their own Core, viz., Alameda and Santa Clara. There was one complete Core cycle this year for the four (4) Northern counties that spanned most of the year, at the request of these counties.

The Advanced Supervisor Series was completed this quarter with the following topics:

- Role of Supervisor in Growth-Oriented Supervision
- Supervisors as Case Consultants
- Supervisors Build Community, Collaboration and Communication
- Generational Issues in Supervision

This was a successful and well-received series that gained momentum as the year progressed. The plan is to repeat it in FY10-11.

The Engagement series was also completed this quarter that included these topics:

- Better Outcomes: One Family's Journey Through the CWS
- Concurrent Planning: Moving into Consistent Practice
- Engaging Families Around Permanency
- Motivational Interviewing
- Youth Engagement

The BAA did its first Training for Trainers this year, with a focus on everything a trainer needs to know to train for the BAA. This effort is necessary for the BAA to be able to expand its repertoire of qualified trainers for maximum trainer availability and to respond to inquiries from individuals not previously training for the BAA. The course was well attended with 17 participants.

A new training evaluation system is now in place that is more robust, versatile and useful. This new customized Microsoft Access program will enable the BAA to put all evaluation data into one place, send evaluations to trainers monthly as well as implement a new trainer evaluation program which will be fully utilized in FY10-11.

The BAA's three trainers developed 15 new trainings this fiscal year, including, but not limited to, "Advanced Assessment", "Advanced Case Planning", "After Hours Refresher For Supervisors", "After Hours Refresher for Workers", "Social Worker Contacts", "Hot Line Assessments", and "Family Team Meetings Facilitation".

The annual Visitation Summit was a successful collaboration of 11 of the 12 counties looking at best practices in child welfare. This summit was attended by 22 county staff and was facilitated by the BAA's own trainer, Margie Albers.

In addition the entire BAA training team was trained on Facilitated Conversation, Consensus Building and Action planning. This was a valuable training for staff as they facilitate meetings throughout the region.

The number of capacity building hours increased and were over-delivered. This speaks to the number of meetings required to meet county needs and the needs of the state, as well as hours of curriculum development to meet individual county needs and requests.

Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project

During the fourth quarter, the Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project (YTP) completed its annual goals for the contract. Last quarter's work to create new hybrid curricula on permanency and youth engagement were used to provide youth-led trainings to child welfare workers throughout California. Additionally, a specialized training was developed on the topic of permanency for adoption workers in Los Angeles.

YTP staff began using their newly developed Best Practices handouts in the last quarter. These handouts were created at the request of training participants and are focused on specific recommended actions and practices that child welfare workers can enact to implement youth recommendations. Previous handouts detailed youth preferences but did not outline specific recommended actions. Staff has received positive feedback on the handouts from training

participants. This quarter staff also completed their marketing and communications strategic planning process. Additionally YTP will soon have a key messages training for all Y.O.U.T.H. staff and have secured funding from a private foundation to continue this work into the next fiscal year. Finally, 26 youth trainers delivered 10 trainings (six full day; four half day) to 310 child welfare professionals in Los Angeles, Kern, San Luis Obispo, Humboldt, Santa Clara, and Solano Counties.

Other primary activities of this quarter included collaborating with the UC Davis Learning Extension, California Connect by 25 Initiative, Breakthrough Series Collaborative on ILP Services, CalSWEC and the Casey Foundation to develop and deliver a Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project-led conference on meeting the needs of transition age youth. This conference was attended by 140 child welfare professionals and foster parents and included the Y.O.U.T.H. Museum of Lost Childhoods, the project's traveling museum of original artifacts youth have donated from their foster care experiences.

Additional Activities and Highlights:

During this quarter YTP completed its first draft of a Three Year Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project Strategic Plan funded by the Zellerbach Family Foundation. The plan, focusing on project growth and sustainability, is now in the editing and finalization process. Y.O.U.T.H. staff are working together to designate specific tasks and timelines associated with larger goals and objectives.

The Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project, in its second year of collaboration with Humboldt County's Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), continues to coordinate the work of the Humboldt County Transition Age Youth Collaboration (HCTAYC). The project supervises a youth advisory board to offer continuous feedback to departmental services for transition age youth. County leadership, line staff and transition age youth in Humboldt County report a culture shift that re-centers transition age youth. There are mechanisms currently in place for youth to offer ongoing feedback and the Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project supports the leadership development of these youth to ensure their recommendations are strategic and sound. This quarter, HCTAYC was invited to present at the Mental Health Oversight and Accountability Committee in Sacramento and also presented at the following conferences/events: California Mental Health Advocates for Children and Youth Conference, Take a Foster Youth to Work Day at the State Legislature and Humboldt State University Distinguished Lecture Series, among others.

The Y.O.U.T.H. Training Project has also continued its Wellness Planning work with both staff and youth trainers. Two long weekend retreats will be offered to youth trainers in July and August. Topics range from physical health and nutrition strategies to grief and loss, health relationships and healing.
