Structure Decision Making Refresher for Staff: Interviewing for Safety
(Safety Assessment Part One: Interviewing for Safety)
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The focus of this class how to use the SDM Safety Assessment to make in depth safety decisions in the field. The main concept is the question of how deeply to dig for each safety threat before deciding whether it is a concern. The class will cover various ways to use interviewing and observation to rule in or rule out each safety threat. This is done by teaching a conceptual approach that will help the worker critical think through each safety threat using the definitions and interviewing strategies.
